## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather a group of friends and family. Get into teams of two. Every person puts money into a kitty. Set your budget for the food.

2. Each pair takes it in turn to cook for the other guests strictly keeping to the budget.

3. The guests arrive for the evening. After everyone has eaten, the guests go into another room, each pair at a time, and secretly score the dinner party.
